1. **Paul Smith Boulevard.** Construction of this road improvement project is underway as part of the Currwood Warehouse project.



2. **Wheaton Park.** The house at 124 Charles Street was removed yesterday to make way for a future playground.



3. **Columbia Gas Video Inspections.** Columbia Gas will begin in April to inspect the City public storm drains and sanitary sewers for “crossbores” where their gaslines literally go through our pipe. This will result in them removing them and we will have video record of our storm drain conditions.

CHART NO. 2 – A&E PARKING DECK WEEKLY OCCUPANCY





CHART NO. 3 – UD PARKING DECK WEEKLY OCCUPANCY




