Economic Development activities included:

Community Development:

The Hagerstown Youth Council held their 2nd meeting for the session on October 23rd and had Mayor Tekesha Martinez as a guest speaker. Youth council members had a Q & A with Mayor Martinez before breaking into groups to discuss their passions and goals for this year’s council!

The Mayor and City Council approved a resolution for the sale of 261 S. Prospect Street for \$170,000 to Miranda Barkdoll under the CDBG Homeownership Program. The contract of sale is now ratified and can proceed toward settlement.

Staff presented programs and services to Pen-Mar Realtors on October 26th at the annual meeting.

Grand Openings & Anniversary Celebrations:

- Horizon Goodwill Industries celebrates the Grand Opening & Ribbon Cutting ceremony for the Mobile Outreach Center. This case management office on wheels removes barriers by bringing valuable services to those in need outside of the City Center.

ENGINEERING

1. **Hagerstown Field House** – the City Council awarded the construction contract to Waynesboro Construction Company. Staff is working with Eastern Sports Management and the design team to execute the necessary contract documents and prepare for construction.
2. **Hagerstown Train Hub Engine 202 Refurbishment** – staff held a pre-bid meeting for the project at City Park, and will open bids in early November.
3. **Hamilton Run Stream Restoration** – the City Council awarded the construction contract for this project at the Greens at Hamilton Run golf course, and staff anticipates that work will begin in early/mid-November. The golf course will be closed until approximately March 1, 2024 when the work should be substantially complete.

CHART NO. 2 – A&E PARKING DECK WEEKLY OCCUPANCY





CHART NO. 3 – UD PARKING DECK WEEKLY OCCUPANCY
