## DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

### Community Development:

At the November 21, 2023 Regular Session, the Mayor and City Council approved a resolution for the sale of 263 S. Prospect Street for \$185,000 to Sven Alstrom under the CDBG Homeownership Program. The contract of sale is now ratified and can proceed toward settlement.

Staff will host the first of two Public Needs Hearings for CDBG funding at the Burobox, 60 W. Washington Street on November 30, 2023 at 5:30 PM. This will open the FY25 Public Service Grant application period.

## ENGINEERING

1. **Hub City Garage** – the contractor erected the first pieces of precast concrete columns and beams at the northeast corner of the parking deck. Erection is expected to continue until mid-February.
2. **Greens at Hamilton Run** – staff met with the contractor that will be performing the stream restoration project at the golf course. The course will be closed to play beginning on December 4<sup>th</sup>, and will remain closed until the spring.
3. **Hagerstown Field House** – the contractor is installing perimeter fencing at the site, and plans to mobilize to begin earthwork next week.

**Media Release:** On Tuesday, November 28, 2023, at approximately 12:51 PM, officers from the Hagerstown Police Department responded to a residence in the 200 block of N. Locust St., Hagerstown, MD, for a report of an unresponsive 6-year-old juvenile male. Upon arrival, officers discovered that the 6-year-old juvenile was deceased. It was determined that the juvenile was suffering from severe malnutrition and starvation. Subsequent investigation revealed that the juvenile’s father, Andre Derek Ford, failed to provide proper care and medical treatment to the child. A second male child, age 5, was also in the residence. He was removed from the home and is currently undergoing medical treatment. An arrest warrant was obtained and served on Andre Derek Ford (1/13/92) and he is currently charged with the following:

- Child Abuse -1st Degree: Death
- Child Abuse – 1st Severe Physical Injury
- Neglect of Minor

Further charges are pending the outcome of the investigation and results of the autopsy. Ford is currently incarcerated at the Washington County Detention Center. This is an active and ongoing investigation. No further details will be released at this time.




