Economic Development

ENGINEERING

1. **Hagerstown Field House:** concrete footings for the buildings are essentially complete, and we anticipate that the erection of the steel building frame will begin on April 12th. The project is still on schedule for completion in December 2024.
2. **Hub City Garage:** the contractor is continuing to place the concrete topping on the ramps and different levels within the parking deck, and has begun installation of the exterior signage. The plan is to have Antietam Street reopened to traffic by the end of April, although there may be temporary lane closures after that date so that work along the front of the structure can be completed.
3. **Pavement Preservation Program:** the contractor milled the existing pavement on South. Burhans Boulevard near Wesel Boulevard., and plans to install the new pavement in that area at the beginning of next week. Work on other City streets will continue through the spring and early summer.

Significant Incidents

4/3/24 - *Vehicle Fire* – At 1025 hrs, Engines 4 and 3 responded for a reported vehicle fire in the 100 blk of W Franklin St. Engine 4 arrived to find a box truck with fire in the engine compartment. Fire was quickly extinguished with only minor extension into the cab area. No injuries reported.

4/4/24 - *Apartment Fire* – At 1534 hrs, HFD units responded to the 100 blk of E Franklin St for a reported apartment fire. Units arrived on the scene with smoke showing from the front door and deployed hoselines, finding fire in the laundry room of an apartment. Crews quickly extinguished the fire, preventing further extension into the apartment. There was one reported civilian injury.

4/6/24 - *Vehicle Accident with Fire* – At 0018 hrs, HFD units responded to Belview Ave for a reported vehicle accident with fire. Units arrived to find a vehicle that had struck a pole and was on fire. Fire was quickly extinguished. Occupants were no longer in the vehicle on arrival. No injuries reported.

Media Release: Apprehension of Homicide Suspect 04/10/2024

An arrest has been made stemming from the October 14, 2020 murder of Daynard Devere Johnson. Johnson was found deceased at approximately 10:30 pm in the 300 block of Henry Avenue with multiple gunshot wounds. Johnson was a 43-year-old Waynesboro, Pennsylvania resident.

On Thursday, March 21, 2024 at approximately 11:30 A.M. EST Raymond Garfield Campbell, 36 years of age, was arrested in Sacramento, California. Campbell has been a fugitive since October of 2020 when an arrest warrant was issued for first degree murder and related charges. Campbell was extradited back to Maryland on Tuesday, April 9, 2024. There is no further information to be released regarding what led to the arrest, but Hagerstown Police Department would like to thank FBI Sacramento and the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department for their apprehension of Campbell. We also want to thank our Warrant Task Force officers that traveled to Sacramento and safely returned to Hagerstown with the suspect. Campbell is currently being held at the Washington County Detention Center.

Officer of the Month: Ofc. Wolfe has been selected as the March Officer of the Month. Wolfe took a simple fraud case and even though returning from SRT training continued his investigation. As Ofc. Wolfe was coming back from training, he observed a female wearing the exact stolen backpack he had been looking for. Ofc. Wolfe stopped his cruiser and made contact. The female quickly fled across Dual Highway. Ofc. Wolfe along with responding officers apprehended the male and female later. The woman had a recent escape warrant and the male had an old warrant. Ofc. Wolfe continued his investigation into the fraud by interviewing the female suspect, who told him where he could recover the victim's important documents. Ofc. Wolfe then proceeded to go to an abandoned house locating a stolen passport, Kindle and other important items for the victim. Congratulations to Officer Wolfe on a job well done.

CHART NO. 2 – A&E PARKING DECK WEEKLY OCCUPANCY





CHART NO. 3 – UD PARKING DECK WEEKLY OCCUPANCY
