**DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**

Grand Openings & Anniversary Celebrations

On Tuesday, July 23 the City celebrated the Grand Opening of “The Franklin” at 34 W. Franklin Street with developers, Troy & Carrie Cosner of Cosner Business Services LLC. This renovation project provides 5 new upper floor housing units and two ground-floor commercial spaces in the CC-MU, as well as bringing new life to a previously vacant building.

## ENGINEERING

1. Dual Highway Safety Improvements – staff is continuing to work with the Maryland Department of Transportation and Smart Growth America to plan for the installation of a demonstration safety project on Dual Highway between Cannon Avenue and Cleveland Avenue. The project will be installed in mid to late August, and will remain in place until November.
2. Hagerstown Field House – all of the concrete floor slabs throughout the building have been completed, and the contractor is working to close-in the central building so that fit-out of the interior spaces can begin.
3. City Hall elevator replacement – the contractor is making good progress on the installation of the new elevator, and staff is hopeful that the elevator will be in operation by September.




