Community Development

Staff was contacted by Hagerstown Magazine to share information on how Christmas trees are selected for the Public Square and City Park.

Grand Openings & Anniversary Celebrations

On Wednesday, August 7 at 5:30 pm we will be celebrating the Grand Opening of the Hub City Parking Garage. This \$11 million brings 398 additional parking spaces to 50 W. Antietam Street with a 5-story deck, including 2 EV charging stations, 2 staircases and elevators. Lt. Governor of Maryland, Aruna Miller, is expected to be in attendance for the occasion.

ENGINEERING

1. **Hub City Garage** – Lt. Governor Aruna Miller and other dignitaries joined a crowd of approximately 100 people for a ribbon cutting ceremony for the new parking garage. The \$11 million dollar project produced a five-level parking deck with 398 parking spaces. Artwork is scheduled to be installed in the windows of the two stair towers in the coming weeks.
2. **Climate Resiliency Funding Opportunity** – staff participated in a virtual meeting with representatives of the US Army Corps of Engineers, the Maryland Department of the Environment, and other agencies to discuss potential flood mitigation projects in Hagerstown that could qualify for Federal funding.
3. **Tropical Storm Debby** – staff are monitoring the effects of the rain from the storm on the City’s storm drainage system, and are inspecting known flood-prone areas to identify problems.

National Night Out: HPD staff coordinated the National Night Out event held at Fairgrounds Park on Tuesday. This annual event seeks to enhance the relationship between community and law enforcement. Special thanks to sponsors and community partners for their generous donations and time to make this event possible. Together, we are building a stronger and safer community.



Neighborhoods 1st: The North End Neighborhoods 1st group recently held their annual block party. Participants enjoyed a picnic meal, a K9 demonstration, children's activities including a Fire Truck. They also collected approximately eighty pounds of canned goods and monetary donations for the Food Bank.

NTF: On August 6, 2024 The Washington County Narcotics Task Force executed a search and seizure warrant in the 700 block of West Washington Street, Hagerstown, MD. The two occupants of this address (Capers and Delaney) were stopped by Agents and a Glock .45 handgun was recovered on Delaney. This firearm was converted to a fully automatic handgun.

Agents conducted a search of the residence. During this search, an amount of suspected fentanyl and suboxone was located. Also located inside of the residence: (1) one Glock .40 handgun, (1) one Glock 9mm Handgun, (1) one Taurus Judge 45/410 caliber revolver and numerous rounds of ammunition and related controlled dangerous substance paraphernalia.

Excellent work by all members of the Joint Washington Co Narcotics Task Force.




