Community Development

Staff have been working with the Hagerstown Housing Authority to plan the Community Fair!

Staff, as well as Hagerstown Youth Council Members, are attending the 8/15 Community Fair hosted by the HHA! Staff will assist with volunteer duties, as well as helping supervise a Choice Neighborhoods interactive activity!

Economic Development

On Friday, Aug. 16 at 11am we celebrate the Grand Opening of Sofrito, Puerto Rican restaurant, at 10-12 E. Washington Street. Local residents, Jeovanni and Yahaira Diaz, purchased the building and through their company HD Telecommunications, restored the building transforming it into an upscale dining atmosphere.

ENGINEERING

1. **Bester Elementary School** – staff met with the school’s advisory committee to discuss concerns about student walk routes. We are working with the group to identify the primary walk routes, and will look to make improvements to ensure that sidewalk facilities along those routes are up to current standards.

2. **Dual Highway Safety Demonstration Project** – staff attended workshop meetings in Columbia, MD with MDOT and Smart Growth America to finalize plans for the temporary demonstration project on Dual Highway between Cannon Avenue and Cleveland Avenue.

3. **Safety Action Plan** – the City hosted a stakeholder meeting with consultants from the Hagerstown-Eastern Panhandle Metropolitan Planning Organization to discuss the development of a Safety Action Plan for the City. This effort, which is funded by a grant through the Safe Streets for All program administered by the Federal Highway Administration, will allow the City to apply for future grants to implement safety improvements in areas that are identified as being high accident locations.

Significant Incidents

8/8/24 – *House Fire* – HFD units were dispatched to the 400 block of Reynolds Ave for a reported house fire. Units arrived to find smoke showing from the rear of the residence. Crews found a pile of debris on fire in the kitchen area, with no extension into the structure itself.

MEDIA RELEASES:

Frederick Street:

On Wednesday, 8/14/24, HPD took a report regarding a shooting that occurred in the 200 block of Frederick Street in the early morning hours of 8/13/24. The incident was caught on home surveillance video and shows occupants in a vehicle fired several rounds. There have been no reports of anything or anyone being struck. Update Jefferson Street Incident (8/14/24):

Additional arrests have been made in the 7/28/24 shooting incident on Jefferson Street. HPD served charges on Jaleel Holmes on 8/6/24 (age 20 of Hagerstown) at R. Adams Cowley Shock Trauma Center where he was hospitalized due to a gunshot wound he sustained during the event.

Holmes' mother, Shacole Rolle (age 36 of Hagerstown) was arrested 8/14/24 for her involvement in the incident. HPD would like to thank the Baltimore and West Virginia field offices of the United States' Marshal Service for assisting us with the apprehension.

On the day of the incident there was a dispute between all three subjects resulting in gunfire and Holmes being struck. Holmes and Rolle have both been charged with: Attempted 1st & 2nd Degree Murder; Conspiracy to Commit 1st & 2nd Degree Murder; 1st & 2nd Degree Assault/Conspiracy to Commit Assault; Numerous Handgun Violations.

Previously released information: On 7/28/24 at about 7:10pm officers responded to the area of the 300 block of Jefferson St for a report of shots fired. Officers then learned that a victim had been taken to Meritus Medical Center for a gunshot wound. The 20-year-old male was later transported to R. Adams Cowley Shock Trauma Center. At this time, it appears his injuries are non-life threatening. On 8/1/24 Rashawd Clemente, age 31 of Hagerstown, was arrested for his involvement in the shooting. We believe this was a targeted incident between Clemente and the victim. Clemente has been charged with the following: Attempted 1st & 2nd degree murder; 1st & 2nd degree assault; Numerous firearms violations




