1. **City Hall Elevator** – the contractor completed installation of the side elevator at City Hall, and it passed its State inspection. After more than two years, the elevator is now back in service.
2. **Hagerstown Field House** – the rooftop HVAC units were installed this week, and the storefront glass installation on the front of the building is nearly complete. Interior frame-out continues on schedule.
3. **Christmas in November** – staff from multiple departments participated in a planning meeting with representatives of the National Forest Service to discuss the planned stop of the National Capitol Christmas Tree in Hagerstown on November 19<sup>th</sup>. Hagerstown is one of the last stops for the tree as it completes its journey from Alaska to Washington DC.


**October 10, 2024:** Luis Fernando Parada, age 26, is currently wanted on numerous Felony charges to include 1st Degree Rape and 1st Degree Assault in connection to the rapes of two juvenile females. Parada is believed to be homeless and staying in the Hagerstown area. The Department is asking if anyone sees Parada, call 911 immediately. **October 11, 2024 - Update:** Luis Fernando Parada was arrested on today's date at about 11:40 am at Fairgrounds Park. We want to thank our community that shared our social media post, the local media for getting the story out and the individuals that started sending us tips. A tipster alerted us this morning to Prada's location and a team of officers moved in to make the arrest. Prada was transported to police headquarters for questioning and will then be transported to the detention center for processing.

We are not aware of any other verified criminal events or sexual assaults but out of an abundance of caution, we are asking the public to come forward if they have any information or are potential victims of Parada. We ask that you contact Det. Vogel at [dvogel@hagerstownpd.org](mailto:dvogel@hagerstownpd.org). A booking photo will not be available until after Prada is processed. We have included a photo taken immediately after his arrest.



**October 7, 2024:** On 10/7/24 at about 10:00 am officers of the Hagerstown Police Department responded to F&M Trust Bank, located at 83 W. Washington St for a report of a robbery in progress. An employee reported that a male suspect, later identified as William Manchester, slid a handwritten note to them indicating that he had a gun, demanded money and threatened to shoot the employee if they didn't cooperate. The employee was able to call the police for help and HPD officers quickly arrived on scene. Officers took Manchester into custody while he was still inside the bank. Manchester ultimately was not in possession of a weapon but threatened that he had one.








