ENGINEERING

1. Hagerstown Field House – basketball hoop supports have been installed in the court building, and the play equipment supplier is installing netting in the turf field building. The contractor will be paving the northern parking lot next week, and is preparing the front parking lot for paving in the next two weeks.
2. Eldridge Drive Warehouse – contractor continues to work on the battalion commanders' living quarters; almost all of the concrete footers for the structural bracing system have been installed.
3. Dual Highway Safety Project – staff collected speed data on Dual Highway near the temporary speed cushions, and compared the data to the pre-installation speeds. The 85th percentile speeds of vehicles have dropped by 6 mph since the cushions were installed. SHA plans to remove the demonstration materials in mid-November.

Significant Incidents

10/19/24 – *Working House Fire* – HFD units were dispatched to 840 Mulberry Ave for a reported house fire. Engine 2 arrived to find smoke showing from a two and a half story duplex. Crews advanced hoselines and found a working fire in the basement. The fire was quickly extinguished while other crews searched for occupants. The fire was held to the basement and did not extend to other floors or the attached occupancy.






A&E PARKING DECK WEEKLY OCCUPANCY




The City of Hagerstown has contracted with Waste Management, Inc. for Hagerstown's **ECYCLES DAY!** This one-day recycling event offers city residents a **FREE and convenient opportunity** to dispose of unwanted residential electronic devices and to securely shred personal documents.

All documents will be transported directly from the event to the paper shredding facility in a secured truck. The documents will then be shredded, baled, and sent to a paper recycling facility where the ink is removed, the paper is turned into a pulp, and ultimately used to create new paper or fiber products.

NEW Secure paper shredding. **ALL DOCUMENTS** will be **PROPERLY DESTROYED** and then recycled!



ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: Computers—CPUs, monitors, peripherals, printers, keyboards, photocopiers, fax machines, VCRs, televisions, stereos, cell phones, home & office phones, and consumer electronics.
UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS: microwaves, smoke alarms & detectors, thermostats, dehumidifiers, any unit with sludge or liquids, non-decontaminated medical equipment, large appliances (refrigerators, etc.).
