DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Community Development

Staff will host the first of two Public Needs Hearings for CDBG funding at the Burobox, 60 W. Washington Street on December 5, 2024 at 5:30 PM. This will open the FY26 Public Service Grant application period, the deadline for which is January 10, 2025.

The Hagerstown Youth Council met on Monday, December 2nd to continue planning the rest of their session, including events, forming committees, and collaborating on service projects. The HYC worked on a volunteer activity for It's a Blessing to be a Blessing.

ENGINEERING

1. Hagerstown Field House – work continues toward an early January opening of the facility. Artificial turf and the sports flooring are scheduled to be installed the week of December 16th; kitchen equipment is being installed, and the paving of the parking lots is scheduled for next week (weather permitting).
2. Security Road sidewalk improvements – staff held a pre-bid meeting for the project to install new sidewalks along the north side of Security Road from Hamilton Run up to the Fairgrounds Park entrance. Work on this project will be completed in the spring of 2025.
3. 32 N. Potomac – the contractor is working on final punch list items, and is attempting to schedule the State elevator inspection within the next two weeks.






A&E PARKING DECK WEEKLY OCCUPANCY
