Community Development

The Hagerstown Youth Council hosted members of the American Youth Association to spread information about the organization, focusing on how youth can get involved with local and state policy.

Hagerstown Youth Council members will be attending upcoming commission and committee meetings. The first event attended will be the Planning Commission meeting on 1/29/2025.

ENGINEERING

1. **Hagerstown Field House** – the facility received its temporary Use & Occupancy certificate, and is hosting its first event on February 1st. There are a number of punch list items to be completed, and some of the exterior site work will have to be completed when the weather improves in the spring, but the facility is functional.

2. **Whole Watershed Grant** – staff is partnering with the Catoclin Land Trust, the Antietam-Conococheague Watershed Alliance, and other entities to apply for funding from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources to address environmental issues in the Antietam Creek watershed. If successful, this funding could be used for stream restoration and tree planting projects along Hamilton Run and other locations in the City.

3. **Customer Service Center** – the customer service and billing staff moved this week to their new location at 32 N. Potomac Street. The contractor is working to get the elevator installation approved, which will allow the Community & Economic Development staff to move to the second floor of the building.



Media Release:

Omega Drive: On 1/29/25 at about 1:40 pm, Officers of the Hagerstown Police Department were dispatched to the area of Omega Dr and Kiwanis Park. A subject walking near the wooded area at that location believed they had discovered human remains. On arrival, officers confirmed the discovery. The body was transported to the Medical Examiner's Office in Baltimore for autopsy. There were no apparent signs of trauma and we will await the autopsy/positive identification results before releasing any further information.

Fatal Collision: On 01/29/25 at 4:00 am Officers of the Hagerstown Police Department were dispatched to the intersection of Halfway Boulevard and Interstate 81 for a report of an SUV that had crashed in to the back of a tractor trailer. Upon arrival the driver of the SUV was found unresponsive and officers began CPR. EMS responded and the driver was pronounced deceased on scene. The driver of the tractor trailer was uninjured. The driver of the SUV is identified as 64-year-old Theresa Marie Poffenberger of Hagerstown. Her next of kin has been notified. Members of the HPD Crash Investigation Team responded and the investigation is ongoing.

Frederick Street: On Thursday January 30th, 2025, at approximately 9:10 P.M. officers responded to the 500 block of Frederick Street for a shooting. Officers arrived on scene and located evidence of a shooting and were alerted to a victim who had been shot through the neck in Frederick Manor. It appears the victim was targeted by two subjects who followed him from the 200 block of Frederick Street. Once they reached the area of Frederick Street and Memorial Boulevard the suspect(s) begin to fire at the victim, striking him one time in the neck. The victim ran to an acquaintance's house in Frederick Manor until he was treated by Emergency Medical Services. 




A&E PARKING DECK WEEKLY OCCUPANCY
