Department Representation at Events

DCED Staff along with Mayor Bill McIntire, Councilmember Caroline Anderson, and Councilmember Erika Bell attended the Multi Chamber Mixer at Meritus Park on March 26th. Where Comptroller Lierman and Commerce Secretary Coker were also in attendance.

ENGINEERING

1. **Intersection Improvements** – the contractor continues to perform demolition and the installation of conduits for traffic signal control wires at the intersection of Summit Avenue and Antietam Street. The goal is to complete the work on the east side of the intersection before the Flying Boxcars' home opener.
2. **Wheaton Park Play Equipment** – installation of the new natural play equipment at Wheaton Park is substantially complete. This is a new, and different, amenity for the residents of the Jonathan Street community, and an enhancement to the park.
3. **Collegiate Acres Parking Issues** – staff from the Hagerstown Police Department and the Engineering Department participated in a virtual meeting with the homeowners' association to discuss parking problems in the development. While there will undoubtedly be continuing issues due to the original design of the development, HPD and the HOA have agreed to continue to work in partnership to address the concerns.

3/21/2025 – HFD units responded for a natural gas line rupture in the 300 block of Belview Avenue. Crews arrived to find a significant leak and evacuated nearby residences, while working with Columbia Gas to control the situation.

3/22/2025 – HFD crews conducted a neighborhood smoke alarm canvassing campaign that resulted in staff knocking on 281 doors and installing 16 smoke alarms.

3/24/2025 – HFD Recruit Class 25-01 began with four (4) recruit firefighters: Jim Balogh, Mason Bailey, Tyler Barnhart, and Dom Rucci. These recruits will undergo weeks of departmental training, as well as state and national certification training prior to being released to operate as HFD firefighters.



3/24/2025 – HFD units were alerted around 4pm with Halfway and Funkstown for a garage on fire on Virginia Avenue in the area of Armstrong Avenue. Engines from HFD and Halfway arrived simultaneously to find a working garage fire with exposure issues. Hose lines were quickly deployed limiting the fire’s spread and then extinguishing the fire that was burning in the attic space of the garage.

Media Release: Two people are in custody after a shooting incident that occurred on Sunday, March 23rd in the unit block of E. Antietam St. Ashley Pennant (age 29 of Hagerstown) and Darryl Lee Robinson Jr (age 32 of Ashburn, VA) were arrested on Monday just north of Waynesboro, PA. Both subjects are being held at the Franklin County Jail on charges of Attempted Murder, numerous handgun charges and conspiracy charges. They await extradition to Maryland. We would like to thank the Washington Township Police Department, Waynesboro Police Department and Franklin County Narcotics Task Force for their assistance in the apprehension. We have great working relationships with our law enforcement partners and this is yet another example. Our officers and detectives have worked around the clock since this incident occurred yesterday evening. Great work all around!

This investigation was supported in part by the Maryland Criminal Intelligence Network (MCIN). The Governor’s Office of Crime Prevention and Policy (GOCPP) supplies grant funding and strategic assistance to MCIN member sites. These resources enable the identification, disruption, and dismantling of criminal organizations through enhanced inter-agency collaboration and data sharing, contributing to a safer Maryland for all.






A&E PARKING DECK WEEKLY OCCUPANCY

Tuesday, March 18, 2025 @ 8:37PM: Supervisor on call received notification about a signal stuck on red at Maryland Ave. and W.
