## Grand Openings & Anniversary Celebrations

On Saturday, April 5 at 9:00 am we will be celebrating the Grand Opening & Ribbon Cutting of Ocean State Job Lot at 17151 Cole Road in Hagerstown, in the former Christmas Tree Shops in Crosspoint Shopping Center. # ENGINEERING

- Intersection Improvements** – the contractor has completed the demolition on the east side of the Summit Avenue/Antietam Street intersection, and has installed the new sidewalks on the southeast corner. Work will now shift to the west side of the intersection.
- City Hall 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Renovations** – the contractor has completed work on the mezzanine in the exterior breezeway; the new HVAC units to serve the first floor and the Council chambers will be installed next week.
- Columbia Gas CCTV** – Columbia Gas’s contractor will be returning to the City to continue their search for “crossbores”, situations where gas mains may have penetrated through storm drainage or sanitary sewer pipes. This is a potentially dangerous situation, as cleaning or maintenance of the storm drain or sanitary sewer pipes might inadvertently rupture the gas main, causing a gas leak.






### A&E PARKING DECK WEEKLY OCCUPANCY

## Hager House - Visitor Center Renovation begins this week



The City of Hagerstown has taken many steps to improve the visitor experience at the Jonathan Hager House Museum to renovate and update the dated museum displays in City Park. The Visitor Center Renovation Project consists of removing the existing exhibit cases, physically renovating the space with new flooring, lighting, and paint, and the future installation of brand-new exhibits and digital displays. Phase I of the Visitor Center Renovation Project has been funded in part by the Appalachian Regional Commission. Beginning April 1, work will begin to deinstall and store the archaeological artifacts discovered on site that have been on display for decades. Over the course of the 2025

park season, museum staff will continue to clean out the current museum space to make way for construction work to renovate the interior space. The lower museum space is expected to be closed sometime during the summer of 2025 for several months. During this time, the upper level of the building will remain open for visitors to see artifacts, purchase from the gift shop, and check in for tours.
