

## BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS OF THE CITY OF HAGERSTOWN

### DELIBERATIVE SESSION

On Wednesday, February 20, 2013, at 7:00 p.m., a meeting of the Board of Zoning Appeals for the City of Hagerstown was held in the Council Chamber, Second Floor, City Hall, Hagerstown, Maryland.

Brett Wilson, Chair; Andrew Durham; Janice Kelsh; and Travis Poole; were present.

The following appeal was considered and decided at the meeting:

**Case No. Z-2012-14.** The Salvation Army, 534 West Franklin Street, Hagerstown, Maryland 21740, pertaining to property located at **534 West Franklin Street**. The Board moved to grant the applicant's request for an expansion of a nonconforming use to allow the expansion of a twenty-eight- (28-) bed shelter to a thirty-seven- (37-) bed shelter for women and children, with the condition that the applicant provide notification through signage or other reasonable means to ensure that all guests of the shelter are made aware that they should try to use the off-street parking provided by The Salvation Army.
