



DO NOT Install Signs or Banners on Utility Poles



Posting signs on utility poles is illegal and dangerous.

Although it seems innocent, staples, nails, tacks and even the signs themselves create obstacles for utility personnel who must climb poles while restoring outages or performing routine maintenance.

Nails, screws, or tacks can puncture workers' rubber gloves, an essential part of their protective gear.

Anyone posting signs illegally on utility poles may be subject to fines up to \$200 per sign. This is in violation of City Code §173-22 and §216-17.
