About Hagerstown

Hagerstown, MD, is a small city on the cusp of big happenings! A Main Street community with a state-designated Arts and Entertainment District and an impressive stock of historic buildings, downtown Hagerstown is currently in the midst of a major construction project that will expand art, event, and education venues. The historic Maryland Theatre and the Barbara Ingram School for the Arts are both undergoing expansion. Immediately behind both buildings, a 20,000 square foot outdoor plaza is being created for events, leisure, and other uses. This plaza joins the pre-existing University Plaza and the Cultural Trail both of which feature numerous works of public art and open space for diverse events. Construction is scheduled to be complete by Spring, 2020.

Hagerstown is the institutional and cultural heart of Washington County and the surrounding tri-state area. It has a proud history initially as a center of agriculture and later as a center of industry. It earned the nickname “the Hub City,” as all the railroad lines running into Hagerstown resembled the spokes of a wagon wheel.

Now. Hagerstown is in a state of transformation. We invite you to be part of the experience as we celebrate the *New Hub City* with arts and cultural programming!
