LEARN THE DOS AND DON'TS OF RECYCLING!

Recycling can be fun, when you know all the rules. It's like a game. And best of all, everyone wins – you, your community, and the environment. The rules of the game are simple: recycle what you can and don't recycle what you can't. Here's a helpful list to know the **Do's and Don'ts of recycling:**



DO RECYCLE:

Recyclable plastic bottles, plastic jars
and plastic jugs (#1 and #2 Plastic only)
Steel/tin/aluminum items
Newspapers with no plastic wrap
Cardboard
Full Sheets of Paper
Magazines without wrappers
Flattened cereal/snack boxes
and cardboard

DO NOT RECYCLE IN YOUR CURBSIDE BINS

Plastic bags or package wrap
Glass
Ceramic materials
Cloth/clothing
Food/yard waste
Hazardous items
Scrap metal
Non-recyclable plastics
Liquids
Frozen food containers
